2023 Tax Checklist; more details if yes to some of the questions

- 1) Name Change: copy of marriage certificate, legal name change certificate, or driver's licence
- 2) Added Dependants: name, birthdate, SIN
- 3) Personal Relationship / Marital Status: ask us for detailed questionnaire
- 4) Banking: if changed, provide void cheque or banking info from on-line banking (must have name on it); we cannot view your current banking info with CRA; both spouses should provide banking info: CRA will pay the Climate Action Incentive to the spouse they process first
- 5) Moved: Old home: residential & mailing address, rent or lawyer docs; New home: residential & mailing address, rent or lawyer docs; new home buyer; ask us for detailed questionnaire
- 6) Sell Principal Residence: year purchased? selling price? joint? owned less than 365 days? If you owned other property like a cottage or if you changed the use to or from rental; we need more info
- 7) Own foreign property or investment that cost more than \$100,000 (including cryptocurrency); own a winter home outside of Canada: provide details
- 8) Financially support a disabled family member: ask us for detailed questionnaire
- 9) Child Care receipts: if an individual provided service need full name and SIN on receipt
- 10) If you pay any child or spousal support, CRA requires a T1158 accompanied by the court order or separation agreement; change to support payments? Need a new T1158; ask us for more details
- 11) Property Tax bill: if under 65 and did not get \$350.00 credit or if over 65 and combined income under \$63,000 (for Senior School Tax Rebate); we need the <u>bill</u> (not just receipt)
- 12) Medical expenses: ask for a medical travel log, look at Awesome Tax Tips; or ask us if not sure!
- 13) Health Care premiums: T4 employment box 85 or year-end pay statement or letter from employer; or T4A pension box 135; or through bank account: get receipt from Blue Cross or others
- 14) Sale of Investments: need statement gains / losses or T5008
- 15) Investment fees: only if paid out of pocket, cannot claim if deducted from mutual funds; interest on investment loan
- 16) Rental property: ask us for Statement of Rental Property
- 17) Self-employed: ask us for Statement of Business Activities
- 18) Social Media Influencers and Video Game Streamers: must claim paid endorsement and sponsorship
- 19) Sale of vacant land / cottage: call us so we can request all details
- 20) Trucker's meal logs: provide logs or calculate for the year (refer to CRA's guidelines); TL2 required
- 21) To claim any employment expenses, your employer must provide you with a signed T2200; if you are salaried, working from home must be more than 50%; for 2023, flat rate is no longer available
- 22) First Home Savings Account (FHSA): you can claim up to \$8,000 in contributions made by December 2023
- 23) Union Dues and Professional Fees / Insurance: you can only claim if paid out of pocket; if reimbursed in part by employer, include invoice / statement for the full amount and reimbursed amount
- 24) New for December 31 2023, trust tax return may need to be filed if you are joint owner on someone else's asset or you added a joint owner to your own asset; for example, cosigning for a home purchase or added to a bank account or holding money in trust for children or grandchildren; let us know so we can help you.
- 25) Underused Housing Tax; if you cosigned for a home purchase for someone else during 2022, you may need to file an UHT return (as a trustee or agent); let us know so we can help you.
